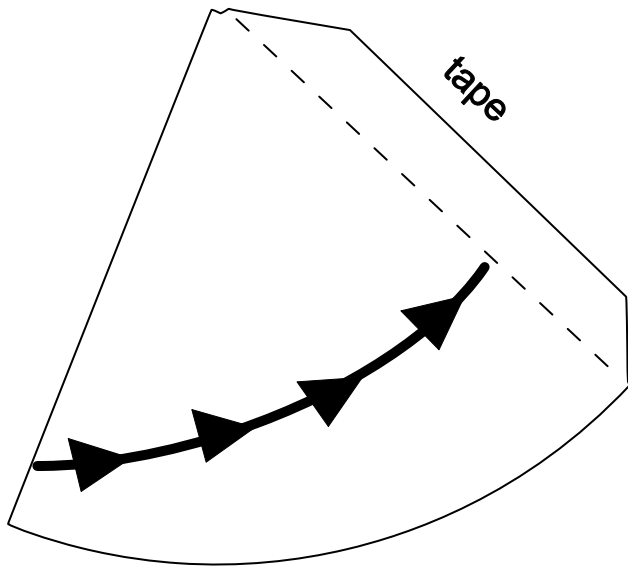


How to Make Paper Trees from Lady Behind The Curtain



Supplies

- card stock paper
- scissors
- optional folding tool
- scotch tape
- skewers (7½ inch)
- brown gel food coloring
- disposable gloves

TIP: if a tree is slipping on the skewer, take the skewer out, and tighten the closing of the top of the tree

Instructions

- determine how many tree shapes you will need (2 large will make one tall tree, 2 small will make one medium) and print.
- Using scissors, cut out each shape or use your Silhouette.
- fold on the dotted line (you can use a folding tool but it's not necessary).
- Take the side without the flap and wrap it under to the flap fitting it snug against the folded dotted line making sure the side with the pattern is facing out. Tape flap to the other side.
- Color the skewers with the food coloring, add a dollop at a time of the food coloring to a paper towel (make sure you are wearing gloves) color the skewers brown to represent a tree trunk. Add more gel as needed. Set aside to dry.
